




"Hashem will surely want to give the Torah on me, I am the tallest mountain in the world! What better, more important place could there be?"

"No! Being tall is no big deal, I am prettier then you Hashem wants me!" While all this boasting and arguing was going on...




There was only one mountain who remained quiet and sad, it was little Har Sinai, a mountain in the desert. Har Sinai thought to himself, why should I say

anything? I don't think I'm special enough for Hashem to choose me for the place to give the Torah I'm




